### NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 3 read with section 13 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Act. No. XI of 1948), the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to revise the minimum rates of Wages for the workers employed in different scheduled employments in the Government Departments, Semi-Governments, Private Undertakings and Contract Works as mentioned in the Scheduled Employments below with effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2016:

## **CLASSIFICATION OF WORK**

- 1. UNS XILLED: Mazdoor (Male & Female), Jhum Cultivator, Agriculture Labourer, Chowkider, Watchman, Khalasi, Cleaner, Loader, Cook, Helper, Sweeper, Breaker (using Manual appliances), Peon, Messenger, Waterman, Water-Carrier, White Washer, Mali Runner, Compositor, Plantation Labourer, Jugali and other categories by whatever name called which are unskilled.
- 2. SEMI-SKILLED: Stone Breaker, Driller, Miner, Cook, Creche-Ayah, Head Chowkider, Mate/Moccadam (without competency certificate under Metaliferous Mines Regulation, 1961), Oilman, Lump Khalasi, Shot Firer, Boilerman, Thatcher, Tindles, Plumber, Trollyman, Jamador, White Washer, Helper (loco, crane, truck) Helper (Carpenter, Blaster, Mason, Fitter, Driller, Blacksmith), Operator, Assistant Mechanic, Butler-cum-cook, Caretaker, Hammerman, Barber, Painter, Fire cutter, Concrete Mixer, Lineman, Meter Reader, Polisher, Conductor, Malee, Security Guard without arms and other categories by whatever name called which are semi-skilled in nature.
- 3. SKILLED GRADE II :(Junior grade having less experience) Blacksmith,
  Carpenter, Compounder, Electrician, Foreman, Fitter, Mines
  Supervisor, Tailor, Head Cook, Engineman, Welder, Blaster,
  Machinist, Head Mistiri, Sub-overseer (unqualified) Surveyor,
  Boilerman, Compressor Operator, Driver, Tractor Driver, Artist,
  Wireman, Compositor, Cameraman, Cobbler, Operator (JCB,
  Dozer, Excavator, Pump, Vibrator, Concrete Mixer, Road Roller,
  Paver Finisher, Lift, Breakdown) and any other which are of
  skilled nature and Clerical Accountant, Assistant Clerk, Munisha,
  Typist, Stenographer Grade II & III, Tool-Keeper, Computer
  Operator, Security Guard with arms and other categories by
  whatever name called which are Skilled Grade II in nature.
- 4. SKILLED GRADE I: Senior Grade having more experience in the line indicated above

### EXPLANATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS NOTIFICATION

- 1. <u>UN-SKILLED WORK:</u> means work which involves simple operation, little or no skill of experience in the job.
- 2. <u>SEMI-SKILLED</u>: means work which involves some degree of skill of competence acquired through experience on the job which is capable of being performed under the supervision and guidance of skilled employees and includes unskilled supervisory work.
- 3. <u>SKILLED II (JUNIOR GRADE)</u>: means work which involves skills or competence acquired through experience on job or through training as apprentice in a technical or vocational institutes and the performance of which calls for initiative and judgement.
- 4. <u>SKILLED-I. (SENIOR GRADE):</u> means expert in the work requiring great skills.
- 5. WORKING PERIODS: The number of working hours per day will be 8 hours approximately for technical works and the number of working hours like Clerical, Peons etc. per day will be as prescribed by the employers.
- 6. PAID HOLIDAYS: Workers other than Clerical, Peons etc. working in the office will enjoy the following paid holidays in addition to the Sunday benefit as enjoyed by the workers provided they work continuously for 6 (six) days a week:-

(a) New Year - 1<sup>st</sup> January
(b) Missionary Day - 11<sup>th</sup> January
(c) Republic Day - 26<sup>th</sup> January

(d) Chapchar Kut
 Good Friday
 as it falls on any day

(f) May Day - 1<sup>st</sup> May
(g) Y.M.A. Day - 15<sup>th</sup> June
(h) Remna Ni - 30<sup>th</sup> June

(i) Independence Day
 (j) Mahatma Gandhi Birthday
 - 15<sup>th</sup> August
 - 2<sup>nd</sup> October

(k) Christmas Day - 25<sup>th</sup> December

- 7. Workers who are engaged in the office will follow the office hours of the Office / Department where they are employed.
- 8. Women and disabled workers will enjoy the same rates payable to the male and abled workers.
- Where the existing rates of wages of any employees based on contract or agreement or otherwise are higher than the rate notified herein, the higher shall be treated as the Minimum rate of Wages applicable for the purpose of this notification to such employees.
- 10. This shall be applicable to all Government Departments, Semi-Governments, Contractors and all Private Undertakings within the State of Mizoram.
