The Terms of Reference of the Committee shall be as follows:

- Review the prevailing rates of wages of persons engaged in employment of Domestic Workers considering Price Index in Local Market etc.
- Submit proposals to the State Level Committee on Minimum Wage for re-fixation of Minimum Wages
 of persons employed under the above stated Scheduled Employment at interval of not more than 5
 (five) years.
- Recommend suitable enforcement machinery.
- 4. The terms of office of the Sub-Committee shall be for a period of 3 (three) years with effect from the date of issuance of this Notification, which may be extended for a total period of not more than 5 (five) years.
- 5. The Sub-Committee shall submit its report/advice to the State Level Committee on Minimum Wages within 3 (three) months from its first sitting to consider revision of the existing Minimum Wages fixed for Employment in Registered Factories not Classified Elsewhere Employees from time to time.
